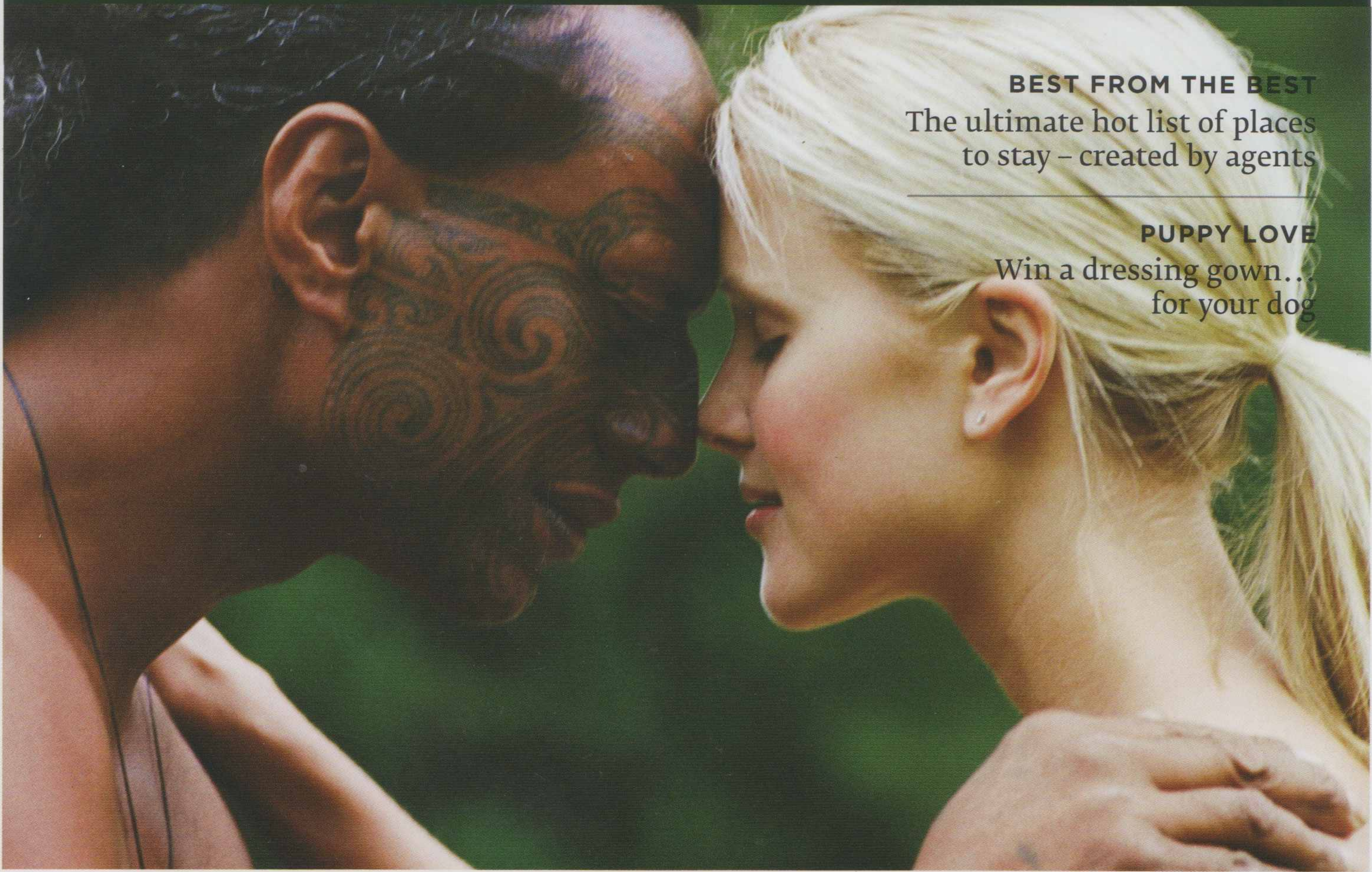

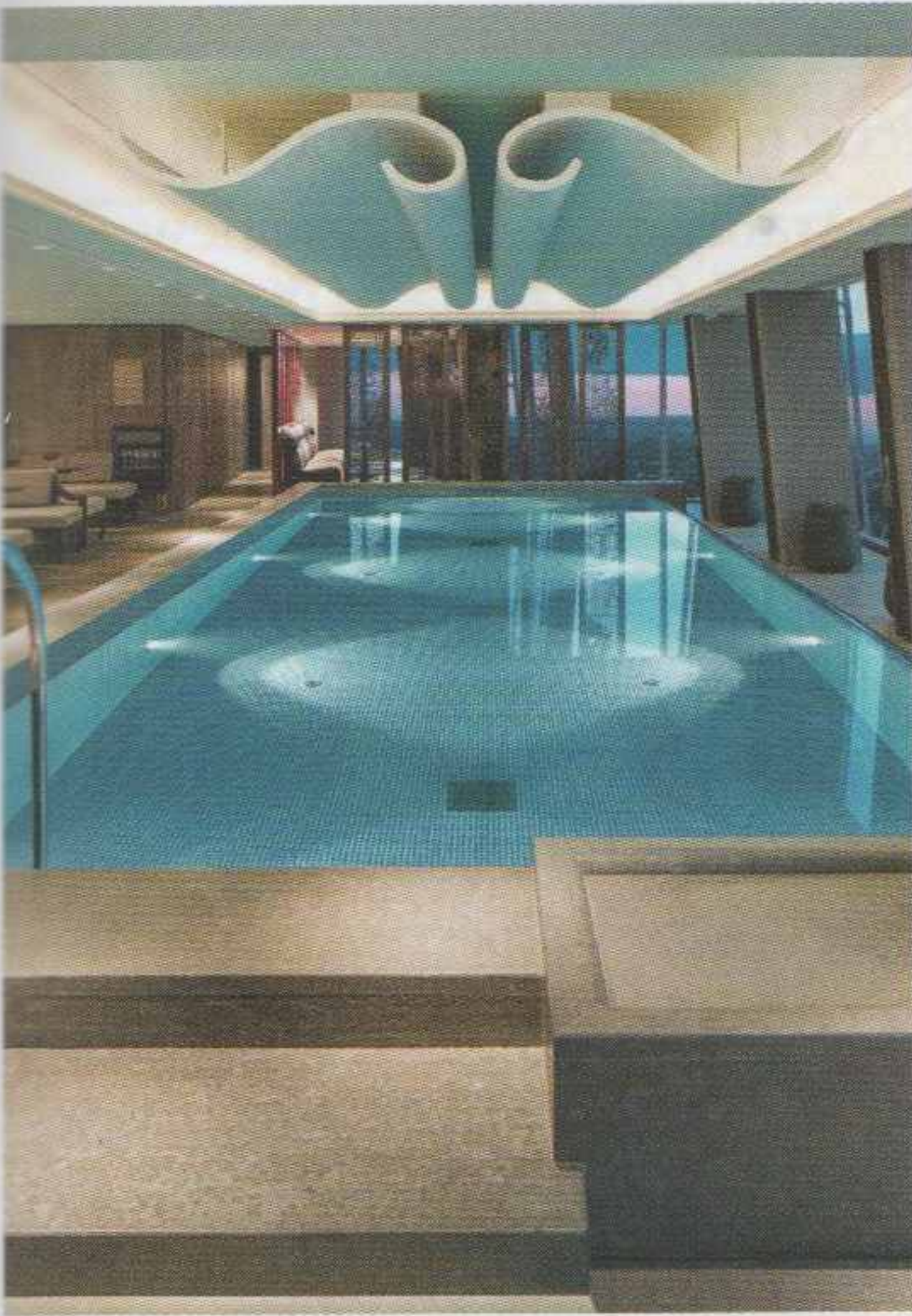

### SUJAN ADDS PALACE IN JAIPUR

Sujan, the Indian and Kenyan palaces, lodges and camps specialist, has added a palace in India to its collection. Sujan Rajmahal Palace in Jaipur, which opens in November, will have 20 suites and rooms, two restaurants, a bar, pool and spa. The palace has hosted the Queen, the Duke of Edinburgh and other members of the royal family, as well as Jackie Kennedy and Lord Mountbatten. The property was originally built in 1729 by the Maharaja of Jaipur and became the official residence of the British resident political officer of Rajputana.
